If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

While APA requires italics for the title of a book, the title of a chapter in a book goes in regular type. Provide the information for the book's editor and the book after the chapter title: Author's last name, first Initial (s). (Year of publication). Title of chapter.

If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location. If the book does not have a DOI and is an ebook from an academic research database, end the book reference after the publisher name. Do not include database information in the reference. Author(s) of chapter - family name and initials, use & for multiple authors. (Year of publication). Title of chapter. In Editor(s) - initial(s) and family name - of book (Ed. OR Eds.). Title of book - italicised (pp. Page numbers). Place of publication: Publisher. In-text reference: Use the chapter authors, NOT the editors of the book
