### Emergency Triage, Assessment and Treatment plus ( ETAT+ ...

Triage involves performing a rapid assessment of a patient; as will be described in some detail in a later section of this chapter, rapid assessment is a two- to five-minute process undertaken by a nurse to identify a patient's presenting problem, collect the patient's basic history and ascertain the patient's current physical / psychological condition.

### Emergency Triage and Rapid Assessment

AIM—To evaluate performance of a simplified algorithm and treatment instructions for emergency triage assessment and treatment (ETAT) of children presenting to hospital in developing countries. METHODS —All infants aged 7 days to 5 years presenting to an accident and emergency department were simultaneously triaged and assessed by a nurse and a senior paediatrician.

### Evaluation of guidelines for emergency triage assessment ...

Post triage disposition and cohorting: Well patients should be directed to another service if available (e.g. purpose designed "COVID Clinic") or directed home by the staff member (nurse and/or doctor) as appropriate according to a locally agreed protocol that balances the small additional risks incurred by well looking patients from this accelerated brief assessment and the risks to the ...

Triage performs a preliminary assessment of current mental health issues, current situational issues and risk assessment of all new referrals and self presentations by: Providing mental health screening Determining the nature and urgency of the response required.

### Crisis Assessment and Treatment Team - Mental Health ...

S.T.A.R.T. (Simple Triage and Rapid Treatment) is a simple triage system that can be performed by lightly trained lay and emergency personnel in emergencies. It is not intended to supersede or instruct medical personnel or techniques. It has been taught to California emergency workers for use in earthquakes.

Background The physician in triage (PIT) strategy was implemented in the emergency department (ED) of the Soroka University Medical Center (SUMC) to improve overcrowding and waiting time. ### **Development and technical basis of simplified guidelines ...**

WHO developed guidelines for Emergency Triage Assessment and Treatment (ETAT) in 2005. In field trials of ETAT, improvements in quality of emergency care reduced early mortality in hospitals in Africa and South America. 3

### **New WHO guidelines on emergency triage assessment and ...**

Triage systems in the developed world are well established in emergency departments. However, Malawi has not had an effective triage system to sort patients over the age of 5 years (for patients under the age of 5 years the WHO Emergency Triage Assessment and Treatment system is in place).

### **Emergency triage, assessment and treatment at a district ...**

AEMT. If hyperglycemia (glucose >250 mg/ dL) with symptoms of dehydration, vomiting, or altered level of consciousness, give 20mL/kg IV/IO fluid bolus. If hyperglycemia (glucose >250 mg/dL) with symptoms of dehydration, vomiting, or altered level of consciousness, give 10mL/kg IV/IO fluid bolus.
