Cerner Scheduling (Level 1) - University Hospital

Open the patient's chart in Cerner for the correct visit (encounter). 2. Click on the PowerNotestab. 3. Click the Add+ button in the upper-right corner to create a new note.

1. After you select a patient, a document or report to print and a printer, right-click over the printer name. Click on Filter Type. It is likely set to Favorites. 2. Change your printer filter type from Favorites to All. 3. Search through the list of printers and select your new printer. 4.

Setup Your Favorite Printers with Your New Printer

Remember, Cerner will keep a log of every record you view, so only view records needed to do your job. However, training is a valid business purpose, so you can explore a little with your practice's patients.
