First (N73999) of five prototypes flew December 8, 1962 and bearing the military designation OH-4A, it was tested against the Fairchild Hiller FH-1100 OH-5A and the Hughes 369 OH-6A, the latter winning the contest.

As a result, the US Army's LOH competition was reopened in 1967 and, on 8 March 1968, Bell's Model 206A was announced as the winner, with production under the designation OH-58 Kiowa starting without delay; some 2,200 of these aircraft were delivered by the end of 1973.
