When teaching students about paragraphs, we talk about the hard and fast rules, such as indenting, having approximately 3-5 sentences, and the structure of it. While I know paragraphs are not set in stone at 3-5 sentences, nor do they always have a main idea as the topic sentence, I like to give my students structure for the foundations and then as they progress expand a bit more with the “hard

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and fast” rules.

There's no hard and fast rule for the exact number of sentences a paragraph should be. Everyone has a different writing style and approach to paragraph construction. As a general guideline, the length of a paragraph is three to five sentences. That said, one-sentence paragraphs are acceptable and often welcome when paired with longer paragraphs.

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
